Subject: Second Training Session for awareness of the Industrial Park Rating System (IPRS)

The Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Ministry of Commerce and Industry, GoI has introduced '*Industrial Park Rating System 2.0*' to enhance industrial competitiveness. The pilot of the Industrial Part Rating System (IPRS) was launched in the year 2018. Based on the learning from the pilot stage, the Government of India started 'IPRS 2.0' in 2020. IPRS 2.0 is a key enabler for identifying additional measures to enhance India's industrial competitiveness. Its objectives are to promote investment and recognize best practices in industrial infrastructure across India and enable states to structure interventions to address gaps and assist in a policy formulated for effective industrialization strategies.

To ensure a high IPRS ranking of Delhi it is proposed to implement the pillar-wise actionable recommendation in all the industrial areas/parks managed by DSIIDC.

In continuation of the training session held on 6th April 2022 on the subject cited above, all concerned departments were requested to submit responses to the questionnaire, but none of the participants submitted the response.

In view of the above, to sensitize and guide the participants with regards to the questionnaire of IPRS, a **second training session has been scheduled for all Estate Managers and Divisional Managers.**
