**CIRCULAR**

Subject: **Enrolment of the Ex- employees and their dependants under the Insurance Backed Cashless Medical Scheme**

In continuation to the circular of even number dated 09-02-2017 regarding the decision of the 263<sup>rd</sup> BOD meeting held on 30-10-2016. It is reiterated that the BOD has agreed to extending a fresh opportunity/open up the scheme for all such retired employees including those who opted for voluntary retirement, who were not members of the IBCMS, or otherwise, against payment of one- time lump sum contribution as applicable for the scheme renewed w.e.f 18.7.2016. The benefit is subject to fulfilment of the below listed conditions:


- The employe should have completed 15 years of regular service for getting 100% benefit at par with the regular employees.
- The dependant family members of those deceased employees who had completed 15 yrs of regular service before death have been allowed to avail the facility at par with retired employees.

All such ex-employees and their dependants who now wish to avail the benefits under IBCMS (for medical policy year i.e. w.e.f. 18-07-2017 and onwards) are requested to deposit the one time lump-sum contribution immediately and not later than 15-06-2017 (based on the respective last Grade Pay drawn by the employee) as indicated in the following table:

Category	Rates of one-time lump sum contribution (Employee including dependants)
Category 'C' Grade pay inclusive and below Rs. 4600/-	Rs. 36,000/-
Category 'B' Grade Pay from Rs. 4800/- to Rs. 5400/-	Rs. 48,000/-
Category 'A' Grade Pay inclusive and above Rs. 6600/-	Rs. 60,000/-

It may kindly be noted that mere remittance of the onetime lump sum contribution will not entitle the willing employees/dependants to avail the benefits of the IBCMS. The decision of the Competent Authority of DSIIDC would be final and binding in all respects.

It is once again requested that all such ex-employees (non-beneficiaries) who wish to avail the IBCMS may deposit the one time contribution by the stipulated date.
