**CIRCULAR**

**Subject: - Enrollment under the Insurance Backed Cashless Medical Scheme (IBCMS)**

This relates to the Insurance Backed Cashless Medical Scheme (IBCMS) of the corporation introduced in 2012 for the benefit of regular/deputationists/retired employees/dependents of deceased employees of this corporation.

The scheme is due for renewal on 29-07-2025, and it is submitted for information that all such retired employees and also the dependents of deceased employees who have not yet opted for the present scheme, are hereby given an opportunity to enroll themselves under this scheme by depositing one-time lump sum contribution. The benefit in r/o dependents of deceased employees is subject to fulfillment of the below listed condition:

- The dependent family members of those deceased employees who had completed 15 years of regular service before death have been allowed to avail the facility at par with retired employees.

All retired employees and dependents of such deceased employees, who now wish to avail the benefits under IBCMS (for medical policy year w.e.f. 29-07-2025 and onwards) are requested to deposit the one-time lump-sum contribution (based on the respective last pay level drawn by the employee) immediately and not later than 31<sup>st</sup> May 2025 as indicated in the following table:

Category	Rates of one-time lump sum contribution (Employee including dependents)
<b>Medical Category 'C'</b> - Pay level inclusive and below Pay level 7	Rs.36,000/-
<b>Medical Category 'B'</b> - Pay level from 8 to 9	Rs.48,000/-
<b>Medical Category 'A'</b> - Pay level inclusive and above Pay level 10	Rs.60,000/-

It may kindly be noted that the policy terms, restrict mid-term inclusion of such ex-employees/dependents. Further, mere remittance of the one-time lump sum contribution will not entitle the willing ex-employee/dependent to avail the benefits of the IBCMS. The prevalent norms of the Insurance policy and the decision of the Competent Authority of DSIIDC would be final and binding in all respects.

It is, therefore, requested that all non-beneficiaries who wish to avail the benefits under the IBCMS may deposit the one-time contribution, detailed below, by the stipulated date i.e. 31<sup>st</sup> May 2025.
